Dear Parents and Carers,

We would like to thank all of our families and children for their continued support as we transition to an extended period of remote learning.

While this is not ideal, we have been here before and know we can continue to deliver an excellent teaching and learning program for our children, with your support.

There will continue to be new learning for all of us and this may be frustrating and difficult at times. Just remember nothing is un-learnable. It just takes effort, which is exactly what the school vision statement says:

*We empower all students to achieve personal goals, experiencing high quality education and the best community for learning. This will ensure all learners have the knowledge, skills and attitudes to become lifelong learners, shaping the world around them and believing that, **with effort, great things can be achieved.***

As a school community we often reflect upon this statement, it defines our core business. Next week the high-quality education will be delivered remotely using Google Classroom. Our staff are working really hard right now – assessing children, writing reports and planning for remote learning. We also know our families and children are also putting in great effort into this new learning platform and we would like to thank you all.

Separate information will be sent to all families soon about remote learning, including 'how to' steps for each of the remote learning platforms/applications/websites/WebEx/Google Classroom and the ICT expectations and protocols. Children will have work set for them each day through Google Classroom. Mondays will be a day set for all specialist subjects and a whole class conference. Tuesday – Friday will be time for English and Maths as well as 1-1 conferences with teachers. Classroom teachers will be making time this week to call families to set up 1-1 conference times.

To monitor attendance, an event will be sent out through Compass instead of children signing in through Google Classroom. This will allow more flexibility for children to complete learning tasks over the day/week. Families will receive notification from Compass and they need to opt in each day. If parents do not do this, children will be marked as absent for that day. The event will be open from 8.30am and will close at 11.59pm each day.



All 1-1 WebEx conferences will be recorded and stored in Department of Educational and Training owned iCloud storage. This is to ensure we comply with all child safety standards.

Parents and careers who do not wish to have the conferences recorded must let classroom teachers know by 9.00am Monday June 7th if they do not wish for their child to be recorded.

We anticipate there may be some difficulties and ask that you direct any questions through the dedicated PLC email addresses to raise any questions.
